

MIFF 2022 Rescheduled For JULY 6-9

The Malaysian International Furniture Fair (MIFF), the largest furniture trade show in Southeast Asia, will now take place on 6-9 July 2022 at the Malaysia International Trade & Exhibition Centre (MITEC) and World Trade Centre Kuala Lumpur (WTCKL).

In addition to an in-person exhibition experience, MIFF 2022 will also provide a digital exhibition solution - MIFF Furniverse - to reach a wider audience and continue to serve the sourcing needs of the global furniture community. At the same time, the exclusive Valued Visitor Programme (VP) will continue to offer complimentary hotel stays to buyers who are interested in visiting the physical show.

"In view of the announcement that Malaysia will delay the opening of its borders to international travelers, we have decided to proactively reschedule MIFF 2022 from 8-11 Mar to 6-9 July to ensure the show is as successful as possible. We believe that the new dates of MIFF 2022 will allow exhibitors to meet with buyers from around the world who have longed for a face-to-face meeting with them," said Karen Goi, General Manager of MIFF.

MIFF will be back as the largest marketplace for Malaysia n furniture exporters, offering predominantly wooden and upholstery furniture for home and commercial use, as well as the widest range of office furniture in the region from Malaysia n and international manufacturers.
